### **Blended Learning at King Henry VIII School**

I would like to clarify how your child is able to keep on track with their learning at home, working independently if they have been asked to isolate from school for a period of time.

It is crucial that your child engages with the home learning if they are well enough to do so. The school has planned for this situation and feel confident that all subjects can support your child to learn remotely. Every subject has a dedicated Google Classroom (GC) and your child should access the classrooms using their **Hwb login**. Guidance including help sheets and 'how to' videos to support you can be found on our website [HERE](#).

The guidance includes:

- ✓ Google for Education a Learners Guide, a document that will help your child to log into using different devices
- ✓ How to use a PS4/ Xbox to access Hwb and GC – this will be read-only;

During periods of isolation from school we would like your child to complete work in their exercise books. They should indicate on the page that they are working from home by writing the side heading 'Work completed during isolation from school' on their work. Work will be checked and marked on their return to school. If your child has forgotten their Hwb login details, please contact main school reception on 01873 735373

#### **What do I need to do?**

##### **First day/s of isolating period**

Students need to ensure that they are able to access their Google Classrooms for each subject. You must login into Hwb first.

##### **Remainder of the isolating period**

During the isolating period students should follow their normal school timetable. For example, if on Monday a student has English lesson 1 then they should log on to that Google Classroom to access the work that has been set.

##### **Wellbeing check**

At some point during your isolation the Wellbeing Leader for your year group or a Wellbeing Learning Support Officer, will call to check how you have worked through Home Learning and offer support should you need it.
