Level 3 Options Pathways

Students will follow a two-year Level 3 Pathway in which they study three or four level 3 vocational courses or A-levels. We would suggest three AS levels for students with mainly C and B grades at GSCE (or equivalent), and four AS levels for those with mainly A and A* grades.

Students will choose the individual components of this course from the options on the application form. Welsh Baccalaureate (WBQ) Skills Challenge Certificate (SCC) at Advanced level has to be taken by all post-16 students. The Skills Challenge Certificate is equivalent to a full A-level.

On your application form please indicate your 5 options in order of preference. Please be aware that we will try to accommodate as many option choices as possible, but the inclusion of a course opposite is not a guarantee that it will run. We have a duty to make sure that every course we offer is viable which depends on the total number of students opting.

If there is an issue with a combination of options we will discuss it with you and suggest alternatives when an offer to study with us is made.

Maths and English GCSE

We strongly advise that all students following a Level 3 pathway should have a C-grade as a minimum in English and Maths. Individual cases of students without one or the other will be considered, subject to interviews with a senior member of staff, and identification of a pathway on which they are likely to be able to achieve success. Re-sit opportunities in Maths and English GCSE will be available for such students.
